



2016-17 TUITION RATES

Dear Parents,

This letter is intended to review information related to our Registration Day and **announce the tuition rate for 2016-17.**

I) I want to remind you that our 2016-17 REGISTRATION DAY will be held on February 23, 2016. Current students and new students can register that day from noon to 6:00 p.m. (no appointment is necessary.) Below are just a few reminders of what is needed to register. All forms mentioned can be found on our website. *Parents of current B.D.H.S. students have the option of attending the Registration day or sending in the necessary payment and forms with their son or daughter on Registration day.*

* All students attending B.D.H.S. in 2016-17 must submit their annual application form and emergency medical form.

* All students attending B.D.H.S. in 2016-17 must submit a \$400 deposit for the 2016-17 school year. The \$400 payment will be credited to your tuition balance. Please make checks payable to Bishop Donahue High School.

* All parents must submit their tuition contract for the 2016-17 school year.

II) The tuition rate for the 2016-17 school year has now been set.

To help defray the cost of tuition, we encourage....

a) All Catholic families should apply for TAP (Tuition Assistance Program) through the Diocese. The TAP Phase I application deadline is April 30, 2016. The Phase II and final deadline is August 15, 2016. **Priority is given to those who register for Phase I.** If you have questions regarding TAP, please call LeAnn Harris at 304-233-1660 (ext. 305). TAP enrollment must be completed online. To enroll, visit the B.D.H.S. website (www.bishopdonahue.org).

b) All B.D.H.S. students can apply for scholarships and are encouraged to do so. All scholarship applications must be returned to B.D.H.S. no later than August 1, 2016. Scholarship applications can be found on the school website.

c) The B.D. Family Plan allows for a \$150 tuition deduction if a family has children attending Bishop Donahue and either All Saints or Our Lady of Peace (grades 1-8). Please notify the school office if this applies to your family.

d) The Aquinas Medal award winner from All Saints and Our Lady of Peace will receive an automatic \$500 tuition reduction their Freshmen year.
