Dear Alumni & Friends,

Greetings from Bishop Donahue and May God Bless You.

As pastors of our Marshall County grade schools and members of the Bishop Donahue School Board, we are actively involved in the spiritual, mental, physical and social well-being of our children.

Our goal is to ensure that the students of B.D.H.S. receive the finest education possible.

However, to accomplish our goal we need your help and prayers. Each year we find that the funds needed to provide a first class education increases. With only three major sources of revenue available, the task becomes more difficult yearly.

Our annual revenue is provided from parish assessments, tuition & fees and 3rd source incomes. The chart graphically shows the total for each revenue source that is used to meet our \$414,243.00 budget.

1995-96 B.D.H.S. BUDGET = \$414,243.81



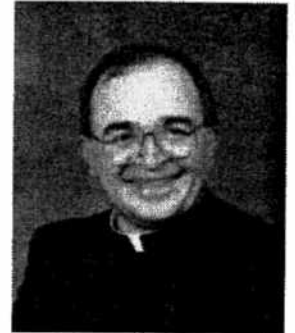
■ TUITION & FEES	\$165,785.00 (41%)
■ PARISH ASSESSMENTS	\$125,133.81 (30%)
■ 3RD SOURCE INCOME	\$116,000.00 (29%)

The school must raise its own 3rd source income, a total of \$119,475.00, which represents 29% of the 1995-96 budget.

Our main thrust in raising 3rd source income is the Annual Appeal Fund. The 95-96 Appeal goal is \$48,000.00, almost double our prior appeal efforts. It was necessary to increase our goal due to annual budget increases.

To meet our goal we are relying on you to make a significant INVESTMENT in our most valuable assets, our students. Your INVESTMENT will allow us to fulfill our budgetary needs and provide our current and future students with the resources needed to be successful.

We ask that you be as generous as possible in making your gift. Remember the importance of a quality Catholic education. We thank you in advance and ask that you keep B.D.H.S. in your hearts & prayers.

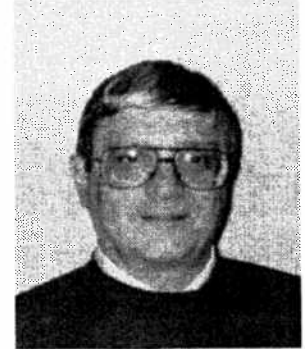

MEETING OUR QUALITY EDUCATION 2000 GOALS

HOW HAVE YOUR APPEAL GIFTS BEEN USED ?

Gifts received from last years Annual Appeal campaign were used to meet several long term goals. A brief description of our improvements have been listed below.

- * **RENOVATION OF CLASSROOMS** - Eight classrooms now have wall to wall carpeting and all classrooms have televisions and VCR's. Special thanks to Mr. Francis Reilley who has been a major contributor to classroom improvement.
- * **LOCKER RESTORATION** - During the past summer all school lockers were sanded and repainted.
- * **GYMNASIUM RENOVATION** - The gym floor has been completely restored. Prior to basketball season the floor was sanded and has been re-painted. Special thanks to ONE VALLEY BANK who provided a major donation to the restoration project.
- * **LIBRARY** - All library books and reference materials have been re-located to the second floor. The old library now serves as a conference center. A portion of the old library was used to create a new office for the school bookkeeper and a storage area.
